## 1999 : Inception of G-20

The G20 was founded in 1999 after the Asian financial crisis as a forum for the Finance Ministers and Central bank governors to discuss global economic and financial issues.

## 2008 : Elevation of Leader's Level

The G-20 was upgraded to the level of Heads of state/government in the wake of the global economic and financial crisis of 2007 and 2009 was designated the "premier forum of economic cooperation". The summit is held annually, under the leadership of a rotating Presidency since then.

# What is G-

The Group of Twenty (G-20) is the premier forum for international economic cooperation. It plays an important role in shaping and strengthening global architecture and governance on all major international economic issues. India held the Presidency of the G-20 from 1st December 2022 to 30 November 2023. The G-20 initially focused largely on broad macroeconomic issues, but it has since expanded its agenda to inter-alia include trade, sustainable development, health, agriculture, energy, environment, climate change and anti corruption.

Prime Minister Modi's address  
summarised in broad points:

1. Multilateralism is in crisis and it has failed in both of its primary tasks of preventing future wars and fostering international cooperation.
2. It is important to give a voice to a global south because the world is sinking as a lot of countries are actually regressing on their sustainable goals pathway while facing challenging debts.
3. The G-20 discussions are naturally affected by the geopolitical tensions of the present day, but we must remember that we all have responsibility towards the countries who are outside the ambit of G-20.
4. G-20 may not be able to resolve certain issues but these issues should not obstruct the issues that can be resolved.
5. G-20 leaders should draw inspiration from India's civilisational ethos and focus on what unites us, and not what divides us.



The first ever G-20 meeting in New Delhi began in February with Union Minister Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurating the two day event, which was a deliberation about sustainable financing solutions.

The G20 group through the 1st Sustainable Finance Working Group Meeting (SFWGM) in New Delhi is sharing a timely message of sustainable investment, the Union Shipping Ports and Waterways Minister said. "As the world continues to battle the fragilities of our fundamental global systems exposed more so by COVID-19, India's G-20 Presidency has come at a crucial midpoint of the United Nations 2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) agenda.
